

The mission of the Cornerstone Volunteer Program is to provide the community at large with an opportunity to serve Christ by serving the students, families, teachers, and staff of Cornerstone Schools of Alabama, through a faithful and committed group of volunteers that work to positively support and promote the Christ-centered environment of excellence in learning, character development, fine arts and service to the community.

Lunch Mentor: A lunch mentor may come to the school Monday through Friday to have lunch with a group of 3-4 students. Our lunch mentors work with our 4th through 8th grade students during their lunch periods and it is a great opportunity for Cornerstone partners and volunteers to get to know our students on a more personal level.

After School Tutor: After school tutors work with our 6th through 8th grade students in reading, math, science, and language. Volunteers may choose any subject or day to come and tutor a student. After school tutors are scheduled for thirty minutes with students between the hours of 3:15p.m. and 5:30p.m.

In School Tutor: Tutors work with our K4-5th grade students in reading and math. Volunteers may choose any weekday, grade, or subject to come and tutor a student. Tutors are scheduled thirty minutes with a student between the hours of 10:00.m.-3:00p.m.

Library Sciences: Volunteers will help our media specialist by reading to the students or helping with library maintenance, such as shelving books and helping students check out age appropriate material.

Lunch Room Volunteers: Every Friday, our lunchroom manager sells nutritious snacks to the 1st-8th grade students from 11a.m-1:00p.m. Volunteers will help pass out the snacks to the students and it is a great way to get to meet our kids!

Group Volunteering: If you have a Sunday school class, civic group, or a few friends looking to make a difference, come on out to Cornerstone! Volunteers will help with cleanliness of the school and school aesthetics.

Office Help: Volunteers will assist front office and/or development office with clerical duties such as shredding documents, stuffing and labeling envelopes, and other office duties.

Women's Committee: Cornerstone's Women's Committee is comprised of a group of dedicated women who volunteer at Cornerstone. Every fall, our Women's Committee hosts its annual Harvest Luncheon fundraiser for the benefit of Cornerstone School.

Men's Committee: Cornerstone's Men's Committee is comprised of a group of businessmen throughout the Birmingham area. Our Men's Committee assists the Women's Committee in the planning of annual fall fundraiser, Harvest Luncheon.

Junior Board: Cornerstone's Junior Board is made up of a group of motivated, young professionals throughout the Birmingham area. The Junior Board hosts Career Day and spring fundraiser, Schoolhouse Rock.
