These leaders established Cornerstone in the Woodlawn neighborhood of Birmingham, where great need is being met with the efforts of talented, certified faculty and staff. Today, the school enrolls approximately 220 students from across the city and offers a challenging, supportive environment centered on learning and student achievement.

To develop a Christ centered, world class learning institution in the inner-city.

Cornerstone provides its students with a challenging curriculum and spiritual formation in order to prepare them for excellence in high school and college. Our commitment to both academic success and faith-based character building also ensures that students will be ready to contribute to meaningful change in the broader urban community.
